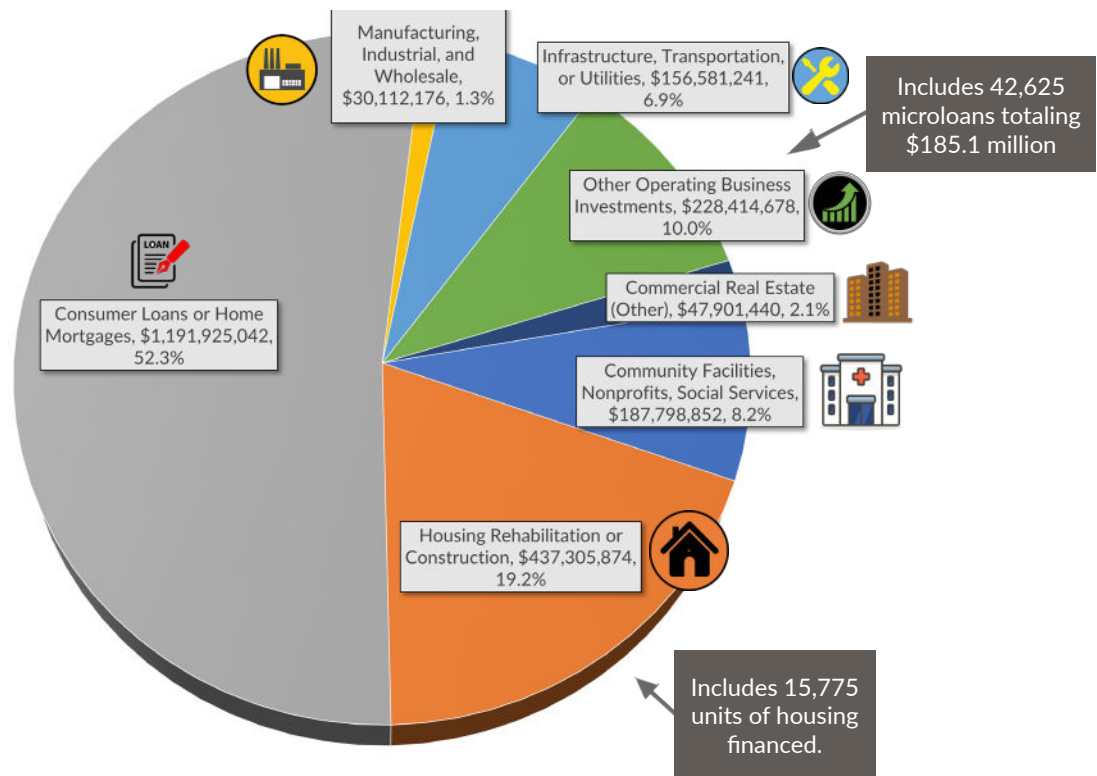

## OTHER FACTS AND FIGURES

- There were 110 certified CDFIs headquartered in California as of February 2022, including 14 CDFI banks, 27 credit unions and 67 loan funds, and 2 venture capital funds.
- Through November 2021, the CDFI Fund has awarded a total of \$9.5 billion in financial assistance, bond authority, and tax credit allocation to California-headquartered CDFIs and CDEs.
